EX	Exceeding Expected Progress Excellent knowledge, understanding and application of both religious and non-religious beliefs. The skill of asking and responding to questions about the world, life and people is usually demonstrated. Written work is very detailed, well presented and explained. It indicates the ability to deploy higher level thinking skills of evaluation and analysis, which can then be applied to the topics studied. It also includes excellent use of philosophical and ethical terms.
ME	Making Expected Progress Shows evidence of knowledge, understanding and application of both religious and non-religious beliefs. The skill of asking and responding to questions about the world, life and people is often demonstrated. An appropriate amount of time is spent on the work, which leads to detail and good explanation. A number of philosophical and ethical terms are also used. Care is taken with the presentation and written work.
WT	Working Towards Expected Progress Some knowledge, understanding and application of both religious and non-religious beliefs is demonstrated, but certain aspects of the work are not clear. Occasional skill of asking and responding to questions about the world, life and people is shown. Answers lack detail, and sentence structure needs attention, as more time could have been spent on the work. A few philosophical and ethical terms are used. Aspects of the presentation need improving as guidelines are not always followed.
